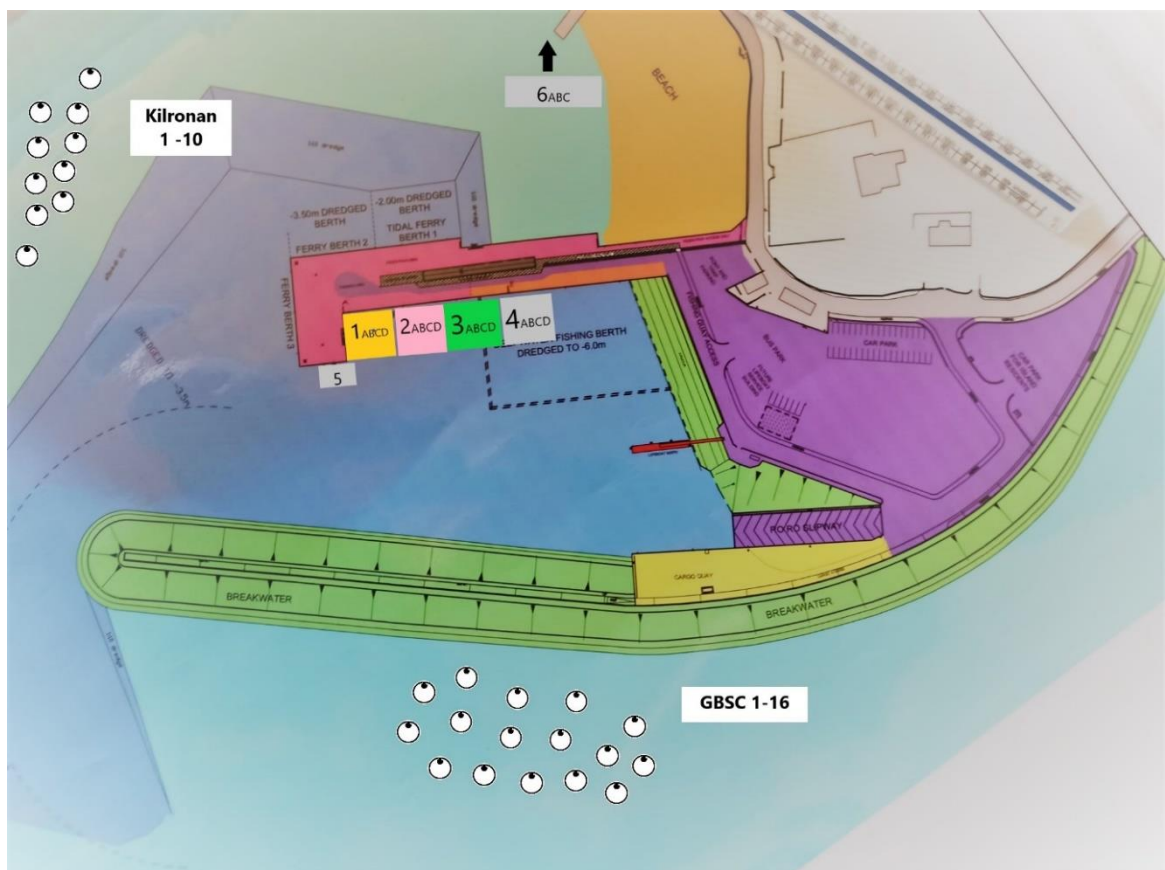
Please see below berthing and mooring arrangements for Lambs week. We look forward to your co-operation in adhering to the plan.

Kilronan

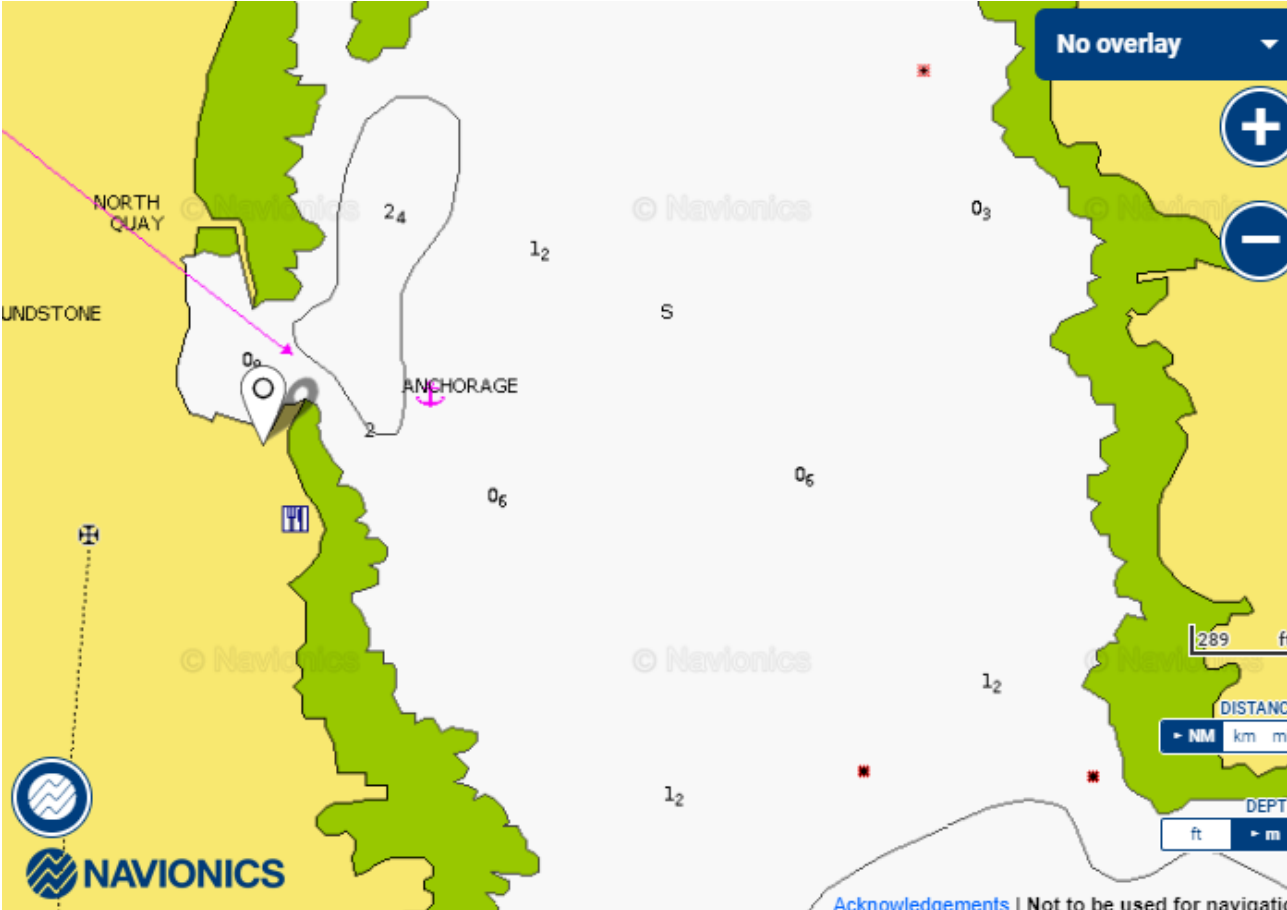
With co-operation from the Harbour Master, we have been allocated some berthing space within the harbour and have also been permitted to place a further 16 moorings outside the breakwater. The table below shows your allocated position. GBSC buoys have numbers. Kilronan buoys do not. A rib ferry service will operate but you may wish to bring your own tender to ensure independence. Throughout your stay please be cognisant of ferry and trawler movements.

Rates and Charges – Please circle the Period requested for berthing i.e. **Short Stay €10, Overnight € 2.00 per metre (minimum €15), weekly € 14/12 summer/winter per metre, monthly €50/35 summer/winter per metre.** Other harbour charges may apply i.e. water, electricity, garbage etc. Boats may be required to move at short notice or raft alongside others as required and rate reductions will not be considered in such circumstances. Cheque/Postal Order/ to be made payable to the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (Cash to be paid at Harbour Office where receipt will be issued): €.....

Compliance with Legislation: The Applicant shall not do or permit or suffer to be done within the precincts of Rossaveel Fishery Harbour Centre anything which would be in breach of any Act of the Oireachtas or Regulations made there under or would render the Minister liable to proceedings being instituted against the Minister under such Act of the Oireachtas or Regulations made there under. In the event of any breach of this clause the Applicant shall indemnify the Minister against all costs, claims, and expenses resulting from such a breach. Harbour Bye-Laws: For the good order and management of the Fishery Harbour Centre, the Applicant is deemed to be conversant with the conditions of this Application, the Fishery Harbour Centres Act, 1968 (No. 18 of 1968) and the Harbour Bye-Laws relating to the management, control and operation of Rossaveel Fishery Harbour Centre, and is expected to comply with the provisions contained therein, insofar as they relate to the business being undertaken within Rossaveel Fishery Harbour Centre.
