ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW NAVIGATIONAL BUOYS

Notice is hereby given that three new lateral marks have been established in the approach channel to the Port of Galway. The navigational aids are lit and fitted with a radar reflector.

The three buoys are located in position as follows:

1. Fairway Buoy #1 53 15.683'N 009 02.340'W FI G 3s
2. Fairway Buoy #2 53 15.654'N 009 02.330'W FI R 3s
3. Mid Fairway 53 15.800'N 009 02.530'W FI R 2s

Fairway Buoys 1 & 2 have synchronised lights.

This local marine notice supersedes local marine notice No. 6 of 2017.

All vessels are to proceed with caution in the approaches to the Port of Galway especially during hours of darkness or reduced visibility and to follow the direction of buoyage and remain in the white sector of the Port Entry Light in position 53⁰ 16.120'N 009⁰ 02.800'W at all times when in the fairway.
